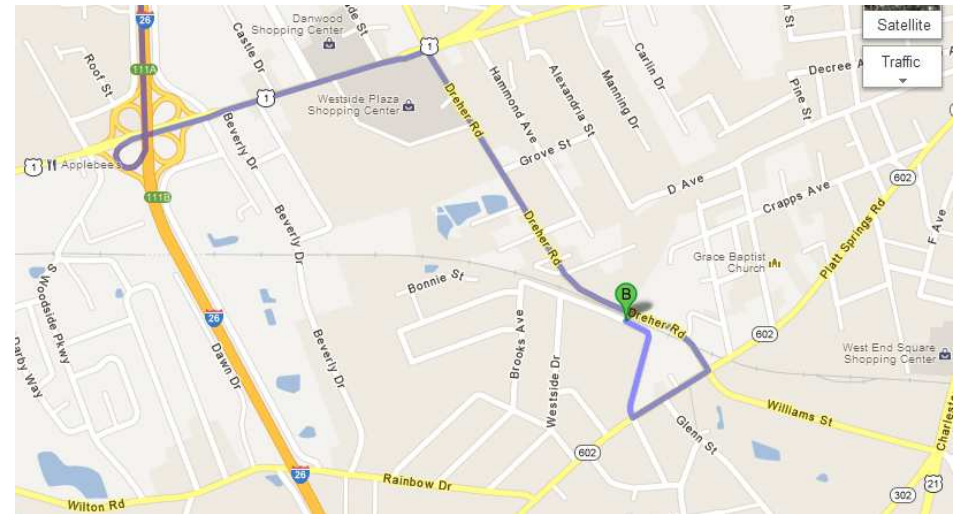

Entry Limitations and Regulations

Combined entries for all classes are limited to 8 hours per judge each day.

Regular, optional titling & preferred class entries have priority, and will be accepted up to the limits for the assigned judge.

Non-regular class entries will be conditionally accepted; after closing and making non-regular class judging assignments, these entries will be accepted in the order received, up to the limits for the assigned judge.

Running order exceptions may be made for handlers with multiple entries.

There are no refunds for errors on entry forms.

Transfers

Transfers will be permitted per AKC regulations until the maximum number of dogs per day per judge has been reached.

A completed Transfer Form must be presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Blank forms will be available at the secretary's table.

The American Kennel Club (AKC) Rules and Regulations will govern this Trial and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the AKC referred to on the reverse side of the entry form in this Premium List

No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. **Signature required, unsigned entries, and entries received without payment will not be accepted. Note: Entry Forms without the full AKC Agreement and Rules and signature on the reverse side will not be accepted.**

Refunds (minus an administration fee of \$5.00 per class) for bitches in season will be mailed to the Exhibitor after the conclusion of the trial if a veterinarian's certificate is presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made.

Entries will be acknowledged via email as they are received and processed. PLEASE VERIFY THE ACCURACY OF YOUR ENTRY INFORMATION as soon as you receive the processing email.

Confirmation and armband number will be sent via email after entries close. Those without an email address will be mailed by USPS to the address on the entry form. Please be sure to add **ShowEntriesInfo.com** to your email allowed list.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Exhibitors alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the ring. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class.

In celebration of GCOC's 50th Anniversary, we will be bringing back some of the non-regular classes we haven't seen for a while including, Veterans, Brace, and Rally Teams. The fun thing about Non-Regular classes is that there are NO qualifying scores and no legs to earn. We do it for the pure fun of competing and showing off our dogs. Oh yes, and we have ribbons for the top four placements.



You may want to compete in **Veterans** with your dogs that are seven years old and older and eligible to compete in AKC. The Veterans class is judged and performed the same as the Novice class in obedience.

If you have two dogs of the same breed or Canine Partners of similar heights you might want to compete in **Brace** –that requires two dogs competing with one handler. The dogs may be joined together with a coupler or handled on separate leads. The Brace class is judged and performed the same as the Novice class in obedience. A separate entry form is required for each dog in the brace.

OR

You may want to get together with three of your friends and compete in a **Rally Team**. We will be recognizing the Winning Team with a **special trophy commemorating GCOC's 50th Anniversary**.

Rally Team is for four dog and handler teams each competing individually, but scores and times are combined for the team. A separate entry form is required for each dog and handler on the team. A fifth dog may be entered as an alternate, but no entry fee is required for that dog.

Awards - Obedience and Rally Titling Classes

First - Fourth Place: Ribbon (blue, red, yellow, white)

Qualifying Score: Green ribbon

Highest Scoring Dog in Obedience Regular Classes: Blue & Gold Rosette.

1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. A or B division.

3. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
