### **Entry Limitations and Regulations**

Combined entries for all classes are limited to 8 hours per judge each day. Entries will be accepted in the order payment is received, up to the judge limit. Transfers will be accepted at the trial per AKC regulations. Running order exceptions may be made for handlers with multiple entries. A completed Transfer form must be presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

**There is 1 Obedience & 1 Rally Trial on Sat and 1 Obedience & 1 Rally Trial on Sun. In accordance with AKC regulations you may not enter more than one class in a trial, except for specific combinations. Please go to the online registration form and Read the Tip Sheet.**

## DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL LOCATION

### **From Spartanburg/Greenville via I-385S to I-26E**

Stay on I-26E which becomes Elmwood Ave. to Assembly Street; turn right on Assembly St. Go 2.2 miles. Turn right onto SC-48E/Rosewood Dr. (SC State Fairgrounds will be on the right, across the intersection.) Go 0.4 miles; take a left on Bluff Road. Turn right at the next traffic light which is S. Stadium Road. 947 S. Stadium Rd. is the last paved lot at the end of the road. GCOC is located in the last building on the right.

### **From Charlotte via I-77S**

Stay on I-77S to exit 5, Bluff Road. Take a right on Bluff Rd. to George Rodgers Blvd. (William Brace Stadium will be on your right) Turn left onto S. Stadium Road. 947 S. Stadium Rd. is the last paved lot at the end of the road. GCOC is located in the last building on the right.

### **From Augusta via I-20E**

Stay on I-20E, merge onto I-26E at exit 64° to Columbia. Stay on I-26E which becomes Elmwood Ave. to Assembly Street; turn right on Assembly St. Go 2.2 miles. Turn right onto SC-48E/Rosewood Dr. (SC State Fairgrounds will be on the right, across the intersection.) Go 0.4 miles; take a left on Bluff Road. Turn right at the next traffic light which is S. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

### INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull

Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

## GCOC COVID Protocol/Criteria

When the COVID numbers were looking much better the GCOC Board decided to establish criteria based on SC DHEC numbers. We were not interested in political agendas, instead we wanted to do as much as we could to protect anyone using our building from being exposed to COVID while on the premises. Unfortunately, there is no way to guarantee a person will not be exposed but using the Richland and Lexington County percentage of positive tests and SC DHEC Community transmission rates we developed our criteria.

Once either County goes over 5% of Positive Testing Rates, we require use of mask. At this time the rate is above 20% in both Counties and the Transmission Rate is Listed as High. If the rate goes down to 5% or lower the mask mandate will be removed.
