Entry Limitations and Regulations

Combined entries for all classes are limited to 8 hours per judge per day. Entries will be accepted in the order in which payment is received up to the limit for the judge or the closing date whichever occurs first. Transfers will be accepted at the trial per AKC regulations. A completed Transfer Form must be presented to the trial secretary 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. Running order exceptions may be made for handlers with multiple entries.

There will be one Obedience Trial and one Rally Trial on each Saturday and Sunday. In accordance with AKC regulations you may not enter more than one class in each trial, except for specific combinations. Please read the Tip Sheet found at the online registration site or visit AKC.org for details.

There is no surcharge for online registration. Per AKC requirements each dog needs a separate entry form, and the exhibitor must sign each form agreeing to AKC's rules and regulations and that they are eligible to show the dog. As your signature you will need to type your name at the end of the dog's information stating you have read and agree to the requirements found on the official AKC entry form on page 4 of this Premium.

You can wait until you have made all Obedience and Rally Entries for all dogs and make one payment. You will get an invoice for each entry but when you go to pay the full amount will paid.

Cancellations made prior to the closing date will be assessed a \$5.00 processing fee. Cancellations after the closing date will be charged the full entry fee except for documented bitches in season per AKC regulations.

No refunds will be given for errors on paper entry forms.

From Spartanburg/Greenville via I-385S to I-126E

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull

Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed afterthe date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner hasreceived theregistration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
