Balance on ball or foam exercise peanut Balance treat on nose or head (e.g., dog biscuit) Carry (such as basket or another object) Catch (soft toy, soft ball, treat, etc.) Close door Close drawer Crawl (at least 5 body lengths-may use food/toy lure) Fetch it (20 ft. away and deliver to hand) Flyball (run to, push, get ball) Game (manipulates interactive canine game) Go find (handler hides, dog goes and finds) Go to your place (to bed/mat, crate from 10 ft.) Hand signals (Sit, down, come, stand. Total of 3.)
